Portfolio Goals

Specifically, my vision includes USATF-NE becoming the flagship association example for a throwers ecosystem that includes:

- grass roots development

- high school, college, post collegiate elite and masters competitive opportunities

- coaches and athletes education

- fostering of the throwers club system

- enhancing masters athletes participation in throwing events

Near term goals for this effort would include:

- Building on the youth clinics we ran through Peter's spring series to include other throwing events

- Getting 2-3 thrower competitions on the USATF -NE calendar that would bring a high energy, well organized throwing opportunity to athletes in need at the right time of year (summer and early fall)

- Running a USATF-NE sponsored throwers coaching clinic

- Develop a throwers championship that would entice USATF membership and club participation while building the community of New England Throwers Clubs. Shining examples of these clubs are Twilight Throwers and Thor's Stone Track Club. I would like to see many other clubs (including my own) step up the this level of organization.

- Marketing to masters aged athletes who either were throwers early in life or want a new fitness hobby but do not particularly like to run or play pickleball. This year I was inspired by the level of volunteerism and organization on the part of the board members supporting LDR and MUT. They serve a large population of masters athletes who love to run. I believe that there is an untapped population of potential masters athletes that, given the right structure, would take advantage of opportunities to take up throwing as their new fitness hobby.
