

2023 USATF-New England  
Indoor Track & Field Points Chase  
Rules for Eligibility

1. Athlete must be a current USATF-New England member
2. 3 results must be from a meet within USATF-New England (NH, VT, RI, MA)
3. 1 performance outside of USATF-New England will be accepted this year
4. The 4 best performances from the 2022-23 season will be scored
5. Athletes should submit all eligible performances, scores will be updated with improved results
6. Athletes accumulate points based on IAAF indoor scoring table
7. Athletes competing at the USATF-New England Championships will be awarded 100 bonus points
8. Results must be submitted by the athlete or coach throughout the season via a link on the USATF-New England website.
9. Track performances must be F.A.T., field event marks must be reported in metric
10. Performances must be submitted with a link to meet results
11. In the event of a tie, the prize will be awarded to the athlete with best single performance
12. Performance window is December 1, 2022 to March 19, 2023
13. All results must be submitted by March 22, 2023
14. High School and College athletes are not eligible to receive prize money.
15. Masters athletes are eligible to participate; however, a separate program will be offered for masters.

**Masters Rules and Exceptions**

**All other rules are in effect.**

1. The next 3 performances score, with 1 performance outside of USATF-New England accepted
2. Awards are based on WMA age graded tables.
3. No bonus points awarded
